“Chase doesn’t remember falling off the roof. He doesn’t remember hitting his head. He doesn’t, in fact, remember *anything*.

He knows he’s Chase. But who *is* Chase? When he gets back to school, he sees that different kids have very different reactions to his return.

Some kids treat him like a hero. Some kids are clearly afraid of him.

Pretty soon, it’s not only a question of who Chase is--it’s a question of who he *was*... and who he’s going to be.”
